


Playing Patchwork with the Silk Set Expansion

3 Player Setup

- Add the new Silk Set patches.
Make a bigger circle or make a spiral if space is limited
- The 3rd player takes the blue quilt board, their 5 buttons, and places their blue time token on the time board
- **The 2 new special 1x1 patches go on top of the 2nd and 4th special patch on the time board.** The first **and second** player to pass these gets a special patch



3 Player Play

- Everything is the same as normal, just with one more player.
As soon as you are no longer furthest behind (your player token is ahead of **one** other player on the time board), you finish taking turns
- See the back of this page for advanced variations

3 Player Variations — These have not been fully play-tested

- **The Mega turn — You will get some big turns, so plan ahead**

The current player continues taking turns until they are in front of **both** of the other players on the time board.

When advancing, move in front of both of the other players on the time board and finish taking turns.

- **Tactical — For seasoned players who don't get confused easily!**

When you are in front of **one** other player, you may **choose** to finish taking turns or continue.

If you move in front of **both** other players, you immediately finish taking turns.

When advancing, you may move in front of **either** of the other player tokens and then finish taking turns.

2 Player Variations

- Add a bit of variety to your game by swapping out some of the standard patches for the Silk Set patches, or select 32 patches randomly
- Always include the standard small 2x1 patch that determines the starting place
